June 7, 2021	18:00-19:00	<a href="#">Leadership 2 link</a>	<p><b>Who is a leader and what is leadership from the perspective of extrAbility?</b> Meet people with and without disabilities who have discovered their leadership abilities and are working for social change for the benefit of all. The session is in memory of Eitan Hazan (1973-2021) who taught us the meaning of victory of the spirit over matter. Eitan was a student in the "Corporate Leadership" course, designed for educators and social activists with extrAbility, and working to promote cognitive-social change. <b>Question from the presenter:</b> How can people with disabilities recognize their leadership abilities and how can they bring about social change for the benefit of society as a whole?</p>
June 8, 2021	10:00-13:00	<a href="#">Art session link</a>	<p><b>Art allows for personal and unique expression for everyone.</b> Art gives people with disabilities optimal space and conditions for social and self-development. Through play and creation, a person's perception of himself and his surroundings changes and makes it possible to experience the extrAbility of all participants. <b>Question from the presenter:</b> What is the role of the arts in the process of self-discovery and social personality development?</p>

			<p><b>discover their hidden abilities and realize their potential?</b></p> <p>In this meeting we will host and talk with three teachers, all blind from birth. Mirka from the Czech Republic who teaches Italian, Vlada from Latvia who teaches music and note reading, and Tehila from Israel who prepares students for matriculation in a variety of subjects.</p> <p>Question from the presenter: How can the educator with extrAbilities develop and improve education?</p>
June 8, 2021	16:00-17:00	<a href="#">Education 2 link</a>	<p><b>Early childhood educators with disabilities and capabilities are privileged to shape the worldview of children and change the attitude of adults towards people with disabilities.</b></p> <p>In this session we will understand how to lead a multi-level process of holistic change, beginning with the child, the kindergarten community, teacher training and the municipal educational system.</p> <p>Question from the presenter: How do you create mutual change in the educational system, including: educators with disabilities, education staff, teaching instruments, supervisors and management?</p>

In this session success stories will be shared from Russia and Israel in which a disability was found to be a professional advantage. Employers were able to create a policy of recognition and reward employees with disabilities by ability, not pity..</p> <p>Question from the presenter: How to create a work environment and conditions that both allows a person with a disability to develop his skills and also is advantageous to the organization?</p>
