



Homeschooling from the point of view of mothers in homeschooling

Abstract

Homeschooling is a phenomenon in which parents seek to reclaim the responsibility for educating their children back to their hands, rather than to school. This article examines the motives of mothers choosing the home education in homeschooling. Based on interviews with 15 homeschooling mothers, the findings indicate that the main drivers were criticism on school and the understanding that "home is the best place for us".
