The charitable fund "Verba" was founded in 2015 by Olga Kitaeva, Jana Kolmogorov Andrei Rozhkov and Dimitry Likhachev at the "Life" Theatre Centre. Historically, "Life" center deals with social rehabilitation of persons with disabilities through art.

When the director, Larisa Abasheva, stepped in, later in 2015, the Inclusive Theatre Group "Zhizn" ("Life") was emerged, it included twenty-five performers including amateur actors with disabilities and able professional actors and dancers.

The performances at the inclusive "Life" theatre bring disabled and able actors together within the same creative space, giving each performer a chance to realize their potential. Sad and funny, wise and kind, the shows created and performed at the theatre had received well-deserved love and recognition from the audience.

The charitable fund "Verba" carries on the tradition of the "Life" center, humanizing the relations between society and the socially vulnerable strata of the population.

At the end of 2016 it was decided that the name of the theatre group should be changed. Since 2017 our project has received a new name and a new slogan: now it is called ORA Inclusive Theatre Group ("ora" means "life" in Maori language), or "hour" (from Italian), and has a slogan "ORA – life in an hour".
